Set at Meeting Held on September 23, 2025

This year’s proposed tax rate exceeds the No-New-Revenue tax rate. The vote on the ordinance, resolution, or order setting the tax rate must be a record vote.

Motion to set the tax rate:

“I move that the property tax rate be increased by the adoption of a tax rate of \$0.220000, which is effectively an 82.28% increase in the tax rate.”

This rate will generate \$2,512,412 in tax revenue, an increase of \$1,338,168 from last year’s tax revenue. This year’s levy to fund maintenance and operations expenditures exceeds last year’s maintenance and operations tax levy.
